



Is it okay to receive different COVID-19 vaccines?

Answer: Usually, yes.

- Health Canada and public health authorities worldwide have approved a number of different vaccines to protect people against COVID-19.
- In Canada, there are 6 approved vaccines: Moderna Spikevax, Pfizer-BioNtech Cominarty, AstraZeneca Vaxzevria, Janssen Jcovden, Novavax Nuvaxovid and Medicago Covifenz.
- It is generally okay to ‘mix and match’ different brands of vaccine: Using a different vaccine for the second dose, or as a booster dose, is considered safe and effective.
