



Vaccination for under 5s

Some COVID-19 vaccines are now available in Canada for children between 6 months and 5 years old. They are similar to vaccines for older children, teens, and adults. The key difference is not the vaccine, but the dosage.

The vaccines are safe: they have been carefully tested and approved by Health Canada, and public health authorities across the world.

Young children have been getting routine vaccination for decades against serious diseases like measles, mumps, and rubella.

Vaccination protects your child against getting really sick with COVID-19 and helps your child's immune system to respond to the virus more efficiently.
