Are English-Speaking Quebecers Part of the Quebec Nation?

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Introduction

Are English-speaking Quebecers part of the Quebec nation?

A majority of Quebecers think so and that includes some three in four anglophones as revealed in a Leger survey conducted for the Association for Canadian Studies in September 2023. While most Quebecers agree that English-speaking Quebecers are part of the Quebec nation, they do not agree that they are one of its founding peoples - an issue nonetheless of disagreement between Francophone and Anglophone Quebecers. Anglophones are far more likely than Francophones to regard Indigenous peoples as one of Quebec's founders than they do French-speaking Canadians. That said, there is diverging opinion around the actual period in which Quebec was founded.

There also remains some confusion around national identities within the Quebec nation. While a large majority agree that the Quebec nation is part of the Canadian nation, they also agree that there is a Canadian nation within Quebec.



Methodology

Leger Marketing surveyed 1,000 Quebecers for the Association for Canadian Studies on issues of historic colonization and its contemporary impact. The results reveal significant differences amongst Quebecers when it comes to the victims of colonization and the question of who founded Quebec.

The survey was conducted during the week of September 18, 2023 by web panel among 1,000 Quebecers (798 francophones, 130 anglophones and 72 allophones). A margin of error cannot be associated with a non-probability sample in a panel survey for comparison purposes. A probability sample of 1000 respondents would have a margin of error of ±2.5%, 19 times out of 20.



Quebecers' Response

Three in four Francophone Quebecers believe that English-speaking Quebecers are part of the Quebec nation, while two-thirds of Anglophones believe that to be the case.

The Founding Peoples of Quebec

Quebecers are equally likely to believe that French and Indigenous peoples are founders of Quebec. Quebec Anglophones are far more likely to believe that Indigenous peoples are its founding people. Most Anglophones see themselves as founders of Quebec but most francophones do not.
